G	Geschlecht: Is the word masculine, feminine or neuter? (dictionary)
K	Konjunktiv: Do you need to use the subjunctive? How do you form it? (82-5)
HV	Hilfsverb: Which auxiliary verb do you need: haben or sein? (7, 237-8)
MF	Mehrfach: Do you need the plural form? How do you form the plural? (dictionary)
NK	Nicht/Kein(e): Which do you need? (20-1)
P	Präposition: Which preposition do you need? (39-42)
PA	Partizip: How do you form the participle for that verb? (R4-6)
PM	Präteritum: Did you form the preterite tense correctly? (16-7, R4-6)
PO	Possessiv: How do you show possession in German? (38-40)
PV	Passiv: Do you need the passive voice? How do you form it? (234-9)
R	Rechtschreibung: Did you spell it correctly? Is it capitalized or not? (dictionary)
RN	Relativnebensätze: Do you need to create a relative clause? How do you form one? (19, 172, 258)
RV	Reflexivverben: Do you need a reflexive pronoun? Did you use it correctly? (188-9)
SZ	Satzzeichen: Did you punctuate correctly (commas, periods, etc.)?
V	Verb: Does the verb agree with the subject? (R6-R10)
WS	Wortstellung: Is the verb 2nd in the main clause? Is it at the end for subordinating clauses (wenn, weil, etc.)? Did you follow TMP (time then manner then place)?
Z	Zeit: Is it present, past, or future tense?
Zu	Zu Nebensatz: Did you use the zu phrase correctly? (258)
Λ	etwas fehlt: What did you leave out?
